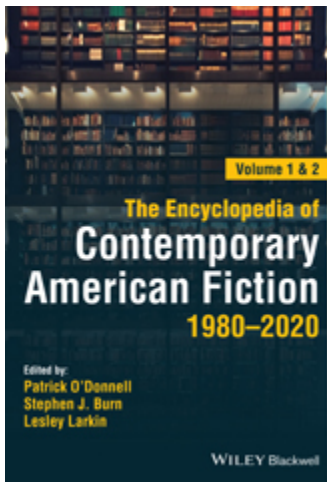


January 2026 Content Update Student Core
