8 new titles were released to Public Core in April 2026. There are now 1,357 titles in Public Core. There were no updated or retired titles this month.

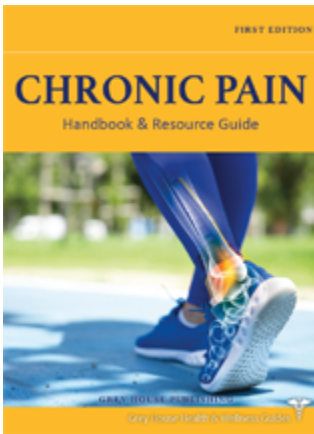
